About the training: Daily, childcare providers administer medication to children for acute and chronic conditions. To date, there has been no statewide effort to support childcare providing in carrying out this responsibility. This training, developed by the American Academy of Pediatrics, gives childcare providers the information they need to safely administer medications. Taught by nurses, the training includes a comprehensive review of state childcare medication regulations, federal ADA mandates and AAP best practice. Training include a practice session as well as ample time for questions.
